WAIM's loading dock is open to accept donations Tuesday through Saturday, 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon. Items that are left when the dock is closed are generally unacceptable by the time we get to them, so PLEASE, only leave items when we are open. Thank you.

- Appliances, large and small including radios and TVs, alarm clocks, blenders, hot plates, stoves and refrigerators, clean and in good working order.
- Baby equipment, recently manufactured (recently increased stringency of safety requirements) clean, with all parts intact and assembled.
- Clothing all sizes in season clean in style in good repair not worn out. (Would you wear it?)
- Flatware, dishes, mugs, bowls, glasses
- Furniture - clean, functional, in good repair—including chairs, tables, lamps, sofas, end tables, beds, chests of drawers, mattresses, box springs, and bed frames.
- Other essential household items.
- Pots and pans
- Sheets and towels - all sizes clean in good repair not worn out
- Toys only if safe for a household with toddlers under three years of age, very clean and with all parts intact.
- Disposable diapers
- Personal hygiene items – unopened bottles/jars/tubes only.
- Large trash bags

WAIM Does Not Accept



- Anything purely decorative, loose parts, and/or not of obvious use.
- Anything that is stained, dirty, torn, chipped, broken, rusty, damp, incomplete, obsolete, smelly, or doesn't work.
- Bicycle helmets
- Books—may be donated to public library's paper-back book exchange.
- Building supplies such as paint, plaster, cement
- Car seats— should only be used once, and WAIM is restricted by the State from accepting them unless they are brand new and in box.
- Computers are accepted only if you call Neenah on extension 13 and get her approval
- Cribs—recent changes in safety requirements—slats have to be no more than two inches apart.
- Exercise equipment.
- Food—may be donated to the Covenant Soup Kitchen at 220 Valley Street
- Games with missing pieces
- Medical items (unless with prior arrangement)
- Office furniture
- Puzzles
- Yarn and fabric— May be donated to Interfaith Sewing group, 1st. Cong. Church, Wmtc.

Please sort items and pack separately when possible.

Volunteers and staff on the loading dock have the right to reject items they determine we cannot use . Thank you for making our job easier so we can spend more time helping those in need.
